




To expose middle and elementary school students to college and to broaden their horizons on how life can be post K-12 education.




## VISION

# The PACE program has two signiture programs


PACE Campus Tours & PACE Workshop

## PACE Campus Tours



Usually run from 12: 00 - 01: 30 PM

- 90-minute program
- A campus tour facilitated by university volunteers
- Executed in large groups

## **PACE** Workshop



Usually runs from 10:00 AM - 12:45 PM

- 3 hour program
- Holistic college experience
- Executed in smaller groups

Seminars about college life, college
application and education.
Group discussion
Dining with college students

Snacks and College merchandise might be provided

## PACE Workshop Sample schedule


